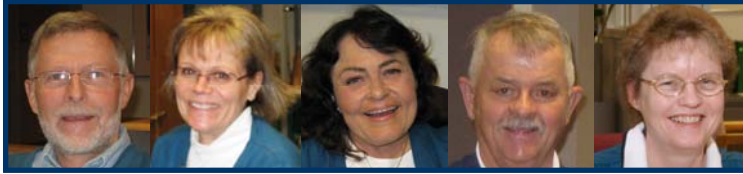

Rose LaHaie, 94 years young, dons her Green Bay Packers garb and makes an occasion out of every game day. Having lived 89 years of her life just 100 miles north of Green Bay in Michigan, it is an understatement to say Rose is a **HUGE!** fan of the Wisconsin football team. Rose is also a devoted Catholic; and, has been known to hold a statue of the Blessed Mary throughout Packers’ games, sending her prayers for a Green Bay win!

When asked about her faith, Rose said simply, “Faith carries you through the difficult times.” In recent years, Rose’s faith carried her through the struggle to control her diabetes. “Even when I was still living in Michigan, I would come to Billings to see Dr. McClave,” Rose shared. Dr. Charles R. McClave II practices at St. Vincent Healthcare Internal Medicine & Diabetes Broadwater Clinic.

“I credit Dr. McClave with keeping Mom alive,” said Dr. Patricia LaHaie, Rose’s daughter and medical director of St. Vincent Healthcare Rehabilitation.

“I could write a book about St. Vincent,” said Rose. Rose had her knee surgery at St. Vincent which was followed by intensive therapies “that only New Hope could provide.” “I thought the staff on the New Hope floor were so wonderful I had to bake them some Italian cookies. Now, they want my cookies all the time!” she grinned.

Rose moved to Montana in 2006 to be close to her daughter. Dr. Patricia LaHaie had joined the medical staff of St. Vincent Healthcare in 1990. “I love Montana,” said Rose. “I loved Montana when I visited Patti, and I love living here.”

Rose’s spirit and energy defy the reality that Rose won’t always be able to bake Italian cookies for the wonderful rehab staff. “I like to be helpful to people. I wanted to do something that would last beyond my lifetime,” she said. That’s why Rose decided to create the **LaHaie Family Endowment for Rehabilitation**. With an endowment, the gift is held in trust at St. Vincent Healthcare Foundation and the annual earnings are distributed to the program of choice.

The LaHaie Endowment will remain in place in perpetuity — carrying out Rose’s wishes forever.
