IRS Status **501(c)3**

St. Vincent Healthcare Foundation is a community owned not-for-profit organization in accordance with section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, U.S. Department of Treasury. St. Vincent Healthcare Foundation is not a private foundation within the meaning of 509(a) of the Code because it is described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

Unrestricted Gifts

Gifts given in an unrestricted nature are appreciated. Unrestricted gifts allow SVH Foundation to direct funds where there is greatest need.

Designated Gifts

Gifts may be designated to capital and program improvements as requested by donors. Designated gifts may include gifts to purchase new equipment, gifts to support outreach programs such as diabetes education, and gifts to support specialized staff such as a pediatric intensivist.

Gifts to Endowments
